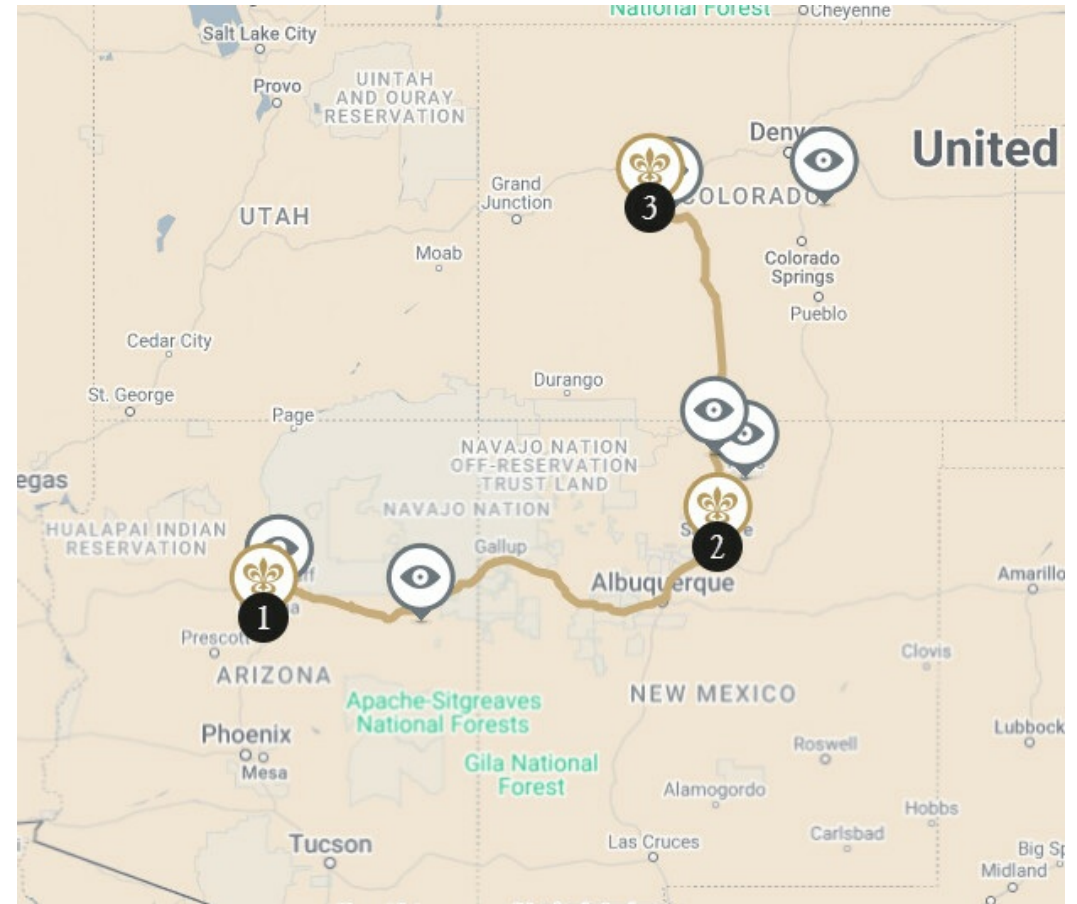




ROUTES DU BONHEUR A journey into the American southwest on a “kindred spirits” spa and vistas tour

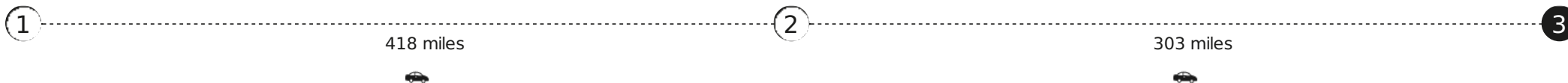
