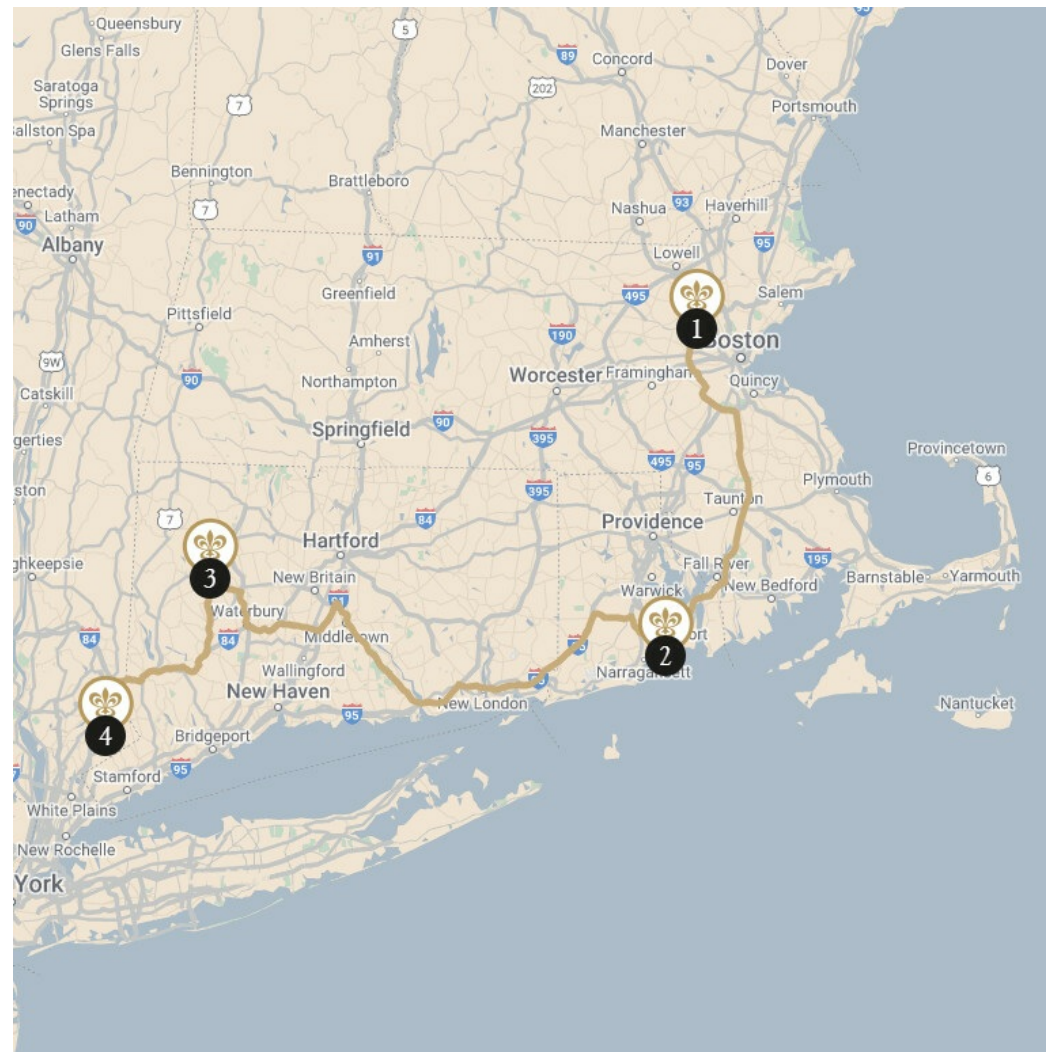

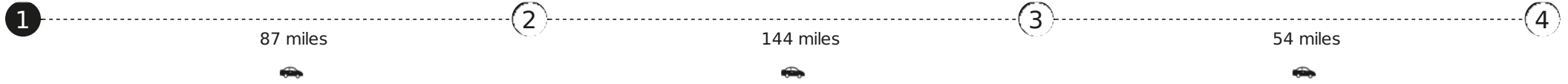

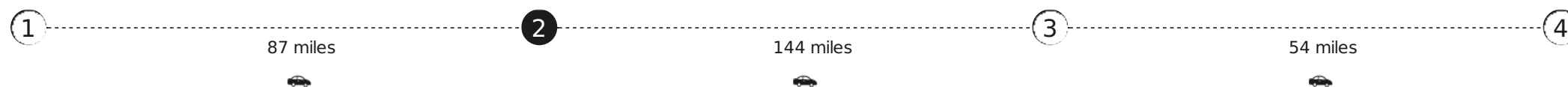
The Inn at Hastings Park

Hotel and restaurant in a village. Discover the Inn at Hastings Park in the heart of Lexington, just steps from the Lexington Battle Green, where the first shots of the Revolutionary War were fired. Considered the birthplace of American liberty, these pivotal moments in history are now an everlasting memory in the quaint, picturesque town of today, just 12 miles from Boston. Enjoy the charms of New England from this carefully restored 19th-century property, comprising three buildings that proudly showcase the period’s evocative architecture. From the property’s sumptuously decorated rooms and suites, guests experience a warm and refined atmosphere that tells a story of an America that is both modern and timeless. The award-winning Town Meeting Bistro tells the same story: the chef reinterprets classic New England cuisine using local produce from artisan growers.

3 MORRIS (CT) — 2 NIGHTS

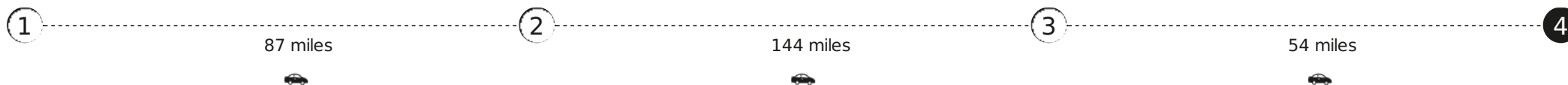

Winvian

Hotel and restaurant in the country. Nestled among the bucolic valleys and pristine lakes of the Litchfield Hills, Winvian is a unique hotel complex with 45 hectares of lush grounds bordered by centuries-old maple trees. A team of 15 architects designed the 18 original chalets and one suite, each with its own special design and atmosphere. Guests can choose to stay in a two-level treehouse 10 meters off the ground, a lighthouse in the middle of the forest, or perhaps a lodge built around a massive oak tree. In addition to the spa, hot air balloon rides, horseback riding, fly fishing, race car driving and other unforgettable experiences are available, all just two hours from the buzz of New York and Boston.
