ROUTES DU BONHEUR China and Japan, from island to island

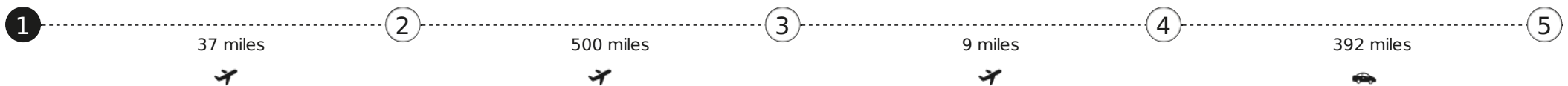

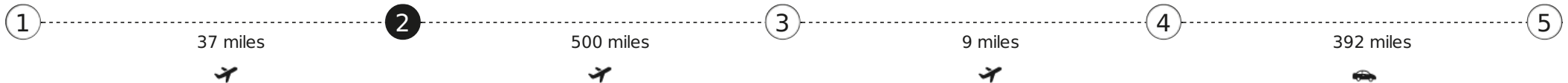

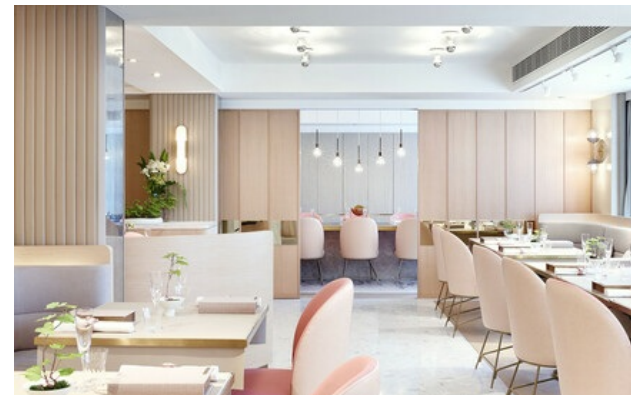

Tate Dining Room & Bar

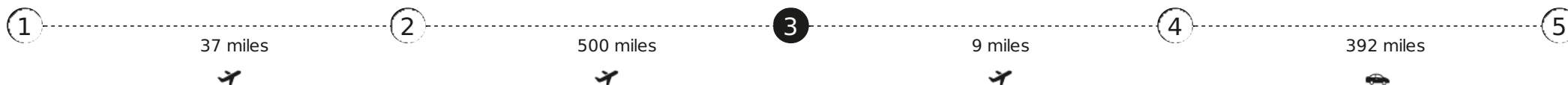

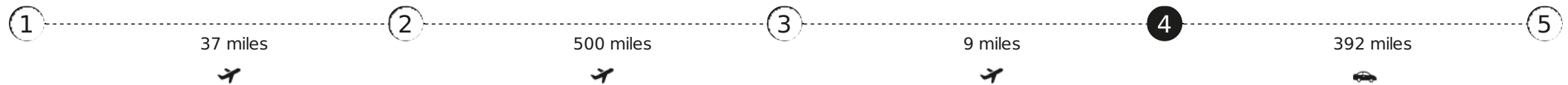
Weekly closing :

4 BEITOU — 3 NIGHTS

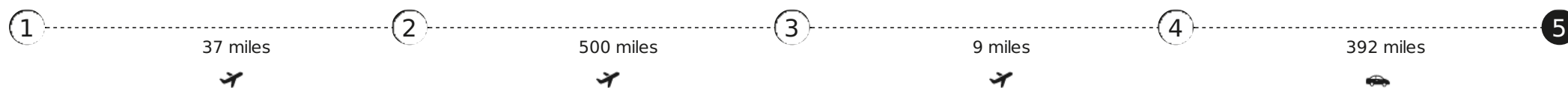
