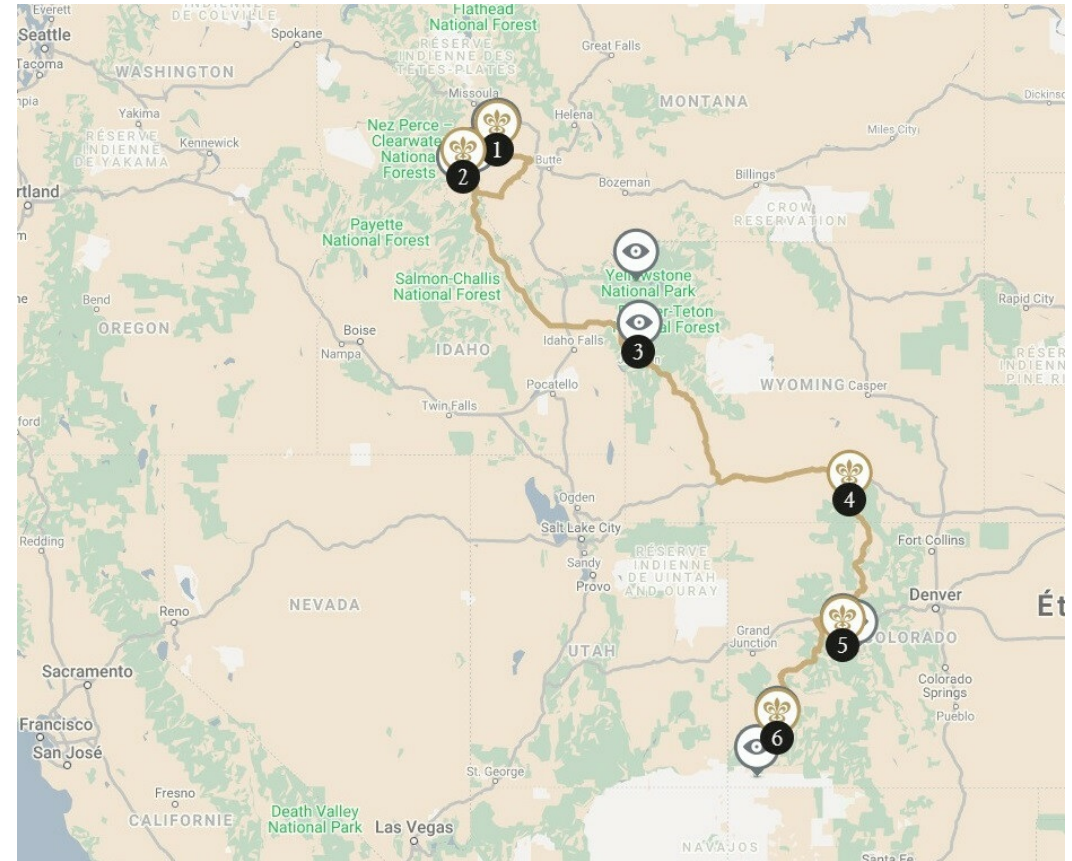

The Ranch at Rock Creek

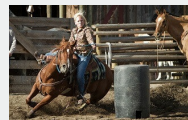

The Little Nell



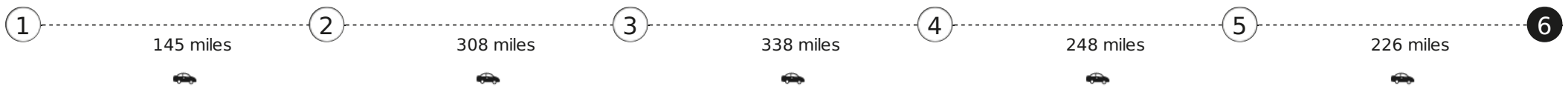
