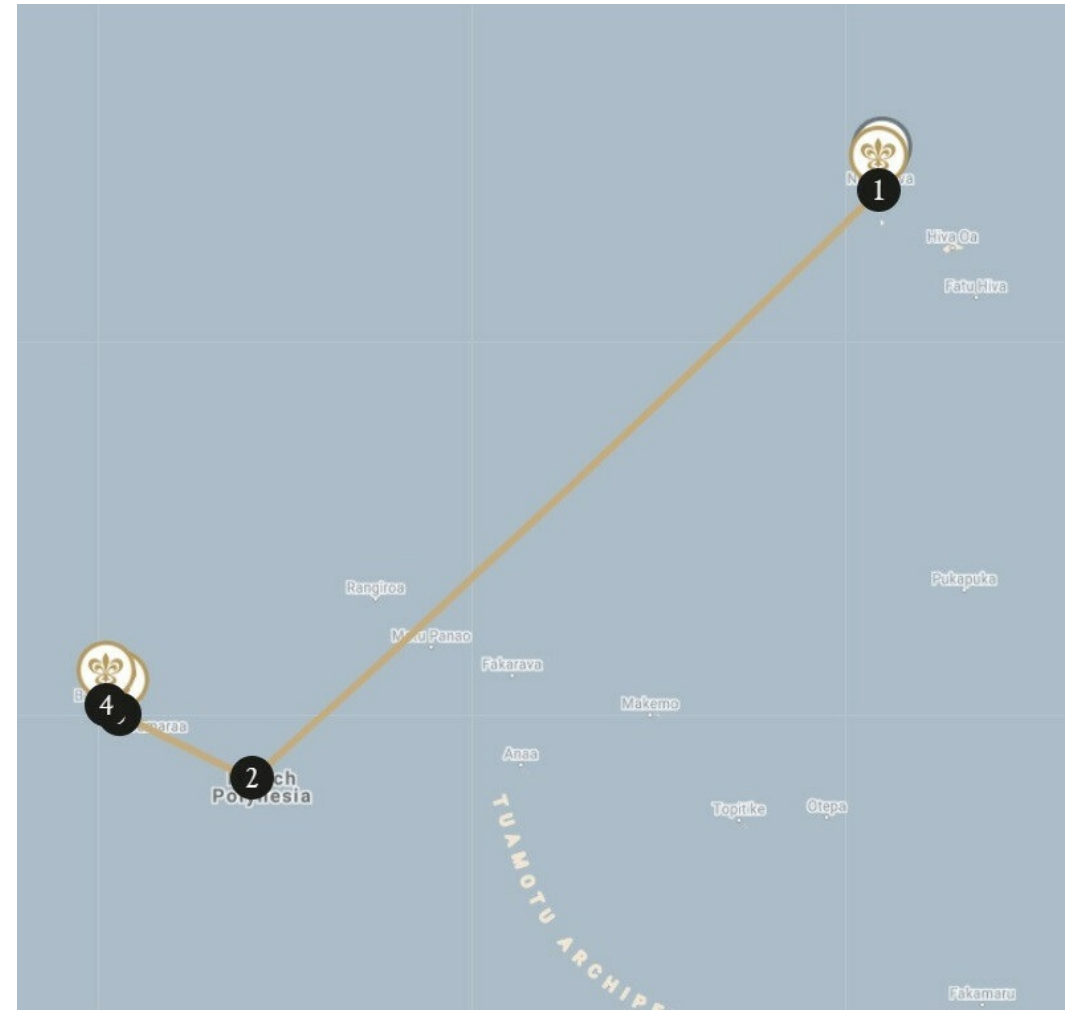


French Polynesia

Meet the Polynesians, explore the coral reefs, and let yourself be carried away by the bewitching magic of the Society and Marquesas Islands.

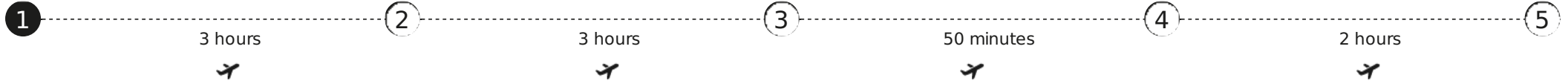

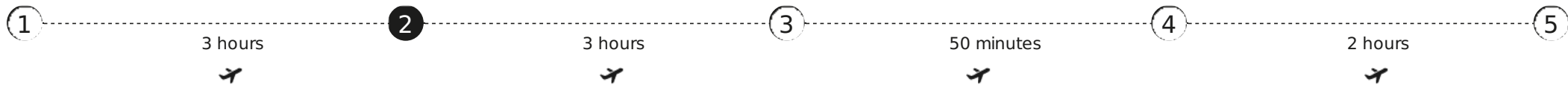

2 TAIOHAE (NUKU HIVA) — 3 NIGHTS

Le Nuku Hiva

Hotel and restaurant on the seafont. In the heart of the Marquesas Islands, one of the most remote archipelagos in the world, the twenty wooden bungalows of Nuku Hiva by Pearl Resorts offer a breathtaking view of Taioha'e Bay and the dramatic peaks of the mountains that encircle it. The property, built from natural materials and decorated by artists from the island, has made "respect for Marquesan traditions" its watchword. The sophisticated and extremely fresh cuisine, which honours the work of local fishermen and hunters, is a testament to this. Offering customised expeditions and stays, the lodge takes you from sea to mountain, where you can explore the island's four majestic valleys, meet locals at the artisan craft markets and discover sacred sites guarded by ancient sculpted statues known as tikis. Afterwards, you may even find yourself inspired to try your hand at wood carving during one of the workshops held on the island.

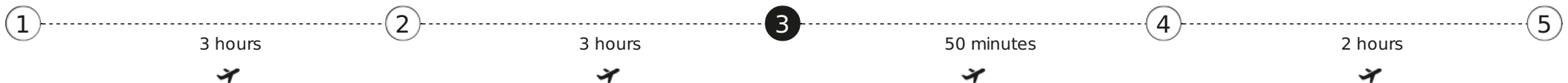

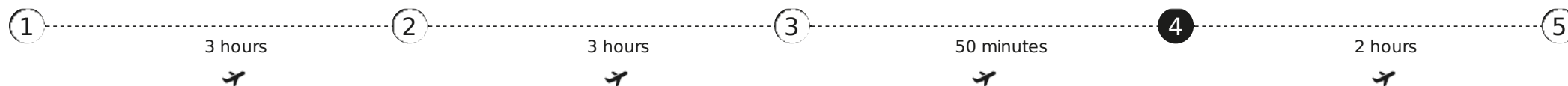

4 PATIO-TAHA'A (TAHITI) — 3 NIGHTS

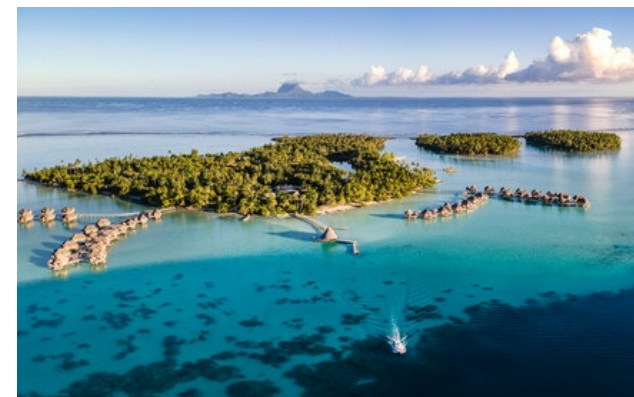

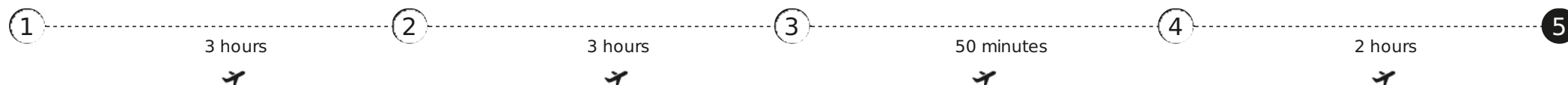

This coral sand island is a five-minute-boat ride away from Taha'a island, famous for its lush vanilla plantations and its black pearl farms. Idyllic, intimate and wonderfully preserved, the thatched huts on stilts of this retreat are in the heart of a natural setting of fascinating beauty, where an enchanting vanilla fragrance and the scents of lush tropical vegetation fill the air. The lagoon has crystal-clear waters and splendid colours and there is an exceptional coral garden.

5 VAITAPE (BORA BORA) — 3 NIGHTS

Le Bora Bora

Hotel and restaurant on the seafont. Delicately set on a coral islet, Bora Bora by Pearl Resorts is surrounded by the crystalline waters of one of Polynesia's most beautiful lagoons, opposite the iconic Mount Otemanu. Not a neighbour in sight, the horizon boasts only lush nature and the immense, soothing expanse of the deep blue ocean. Here, three types of fare (traditional houses) covered with plaited pandan leaves welcome guests: villas nestled in the coconut grove, suites opening onto the beach or bungalows mounted on stilts in the lagoon. Creating an archipelago of tranquillity, their elegance is matched only by their comfort: you need simply venture out onto the terraces or to the private swimming pools to discover the Tāvai Spa's magical treatments, explore coral gardens with a mask and snorkel, or take a trip aboard the Okeanos Pearl, the property's solar-powered catamaran. At this extraordinary site, every detail has been designed to satisfy the senses.
